The essence

Realisation of the high status of human being and its value in political thoughts on one hand and same time regarding the wide spread of these new discourses on the topic of human rights and its international and local dimensions which have resulted in different effects and consequences like new mandates for governments on the other hand, makes taking of the subject of human rights through Imam's angle important in two aspects, first: need for making clear part of Imam's political science theory on government and its legal mandates especially on the international level [especially] regarding his theoretical bases on ontology and anthropology, on which no proper efforts yet been spent.
