

International Day of Quds: Symbol of Unity

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In order to neutralize the plots of International Zionism against Muslims, Imam Khomeini called on all Muslims, following different Islamic schools of thought, to get united. He warned against discord among Muslim-brothers: "Muslims should be wakeful, Muslims should be alert that if a dispute takes place among Sunni and Shia brothers, it is harmful to all of us, it is harmful to all Muslims. Those who want to sow discord

are neither Sunni nor Shia, they are agents of the superpowers and work for them. Those who attempt to cause discord among our Sunni and Shia brothers are people who conspire for the enemies of Islam and want the enemies of Islam to triumph over Muslims."

In a move to unite all Muslims of the world against the main enemy, Imam Khomeini declared the last Friday of the holy month of Ramadan as the International Day of Quds. Hence, Muslims across

the world organize demonstrations and rallies on this day to announce their unity against the Zionist regime. This year's International Day of Quds bears a special significance because for the first time in the history of Israel, the Zionist regime was defeated in its invasion of South Lebanon and Gaza. During the 33-Day and 22-Day Wars the Palestinians and Lebanese proved that formidability of Israel is a mere myth. Hence, on the last Friday of the holy Month of Ramadan, Muslims across the world will once again get united to expose the real nature of the occupiers of Palestine.



The victory of the Islamic Revolution of Iran and the establishment of the Islamic government is the strongest proof for the disinherited masses, particularly the Muslims, to have faith in the capabilities of Islam and ability of the Muslim leaders to bring about profound social changes and guide society towards felicity and perfection in the light of the Islamic ideology and culture. Also the establishment of the Islamic government in an Islamic country could raise hopes in many disinherited masses, encouraging them to realize that they can utilize religious government to put forth the idea of their supervision at an international level.

Commenting on the impact of the Islamic uprising of the Iranian nation on the revival of the Islamic culture and Islamic awakening, Imam Khomeini states:

“They were destroying Islam;. They were trampling the Quran under their boots. The uprising of the Iranian youth, the uprising of the Iranian nation, which was a divine uprising, revived the Quran; and Islam.”

Also alluding to the capabilities of Islam in bringing about changes in the social, governmental structures and establishment of a popular revolution and government, the Imam says:

“The great change that has emerged in the nation was a change that did not aim only to eliminate the regime...the nation wanted an Islamic government. It was the fundamental issue, that is, they wanted the Quran to rule supreme. They removed the hurdles in this country to establish an Islamic government.”
