

## **A study on the kinds of pilgrims of Imam Khomeini's Tombs and investigating the degree of their satisfaction**

### **The essence**

This study is on typology of Imam tomb's pilgrims and measuring the degree of their political satisfaction, the kind of research is descriptive and its method measurement. The statistical sample have been of the above 18 pilgrims on the internal precinct of the tomb.

The result's been analysed through *SPSS* method, typology of pilgrims done besides description of their social appearance, also their social and economic stand have been noticed and political study done through the meaning of political satisfaction. The origin and bases of most of the pilgrims were mediocre (50.2% , 76.2%), 26% of pilgrims were of low class origin who after revolution were upgraded to middle social – economic class. 56% of pilgrims were generally in average or high level of satisfaction.

According to the Pearson Correlation Coefficient test in spite of lack of correlation in between [social] origin and political satisfaction, there is an opposite correlation between social – economic stand and political satisfaction as(0.0126) and (0.012), meaning pilgrims of the lower class expressed higher political satisfaction.
